This notice provides official information regarding the Town of Highland Beach's 2026 General Municipal Election, specifically to candidates running for office.

The qualifying period for candidates ended today, Tuesday, November 25, 2025, at noon. The candidates listed below filed their qualifying papers and each ran without opposition. In accordance with Florida election law, unopposed candidates are deemed to have voted for themselves, and therefore their names will not appear on the ballot.

Because both candidates were unopposed and are considered to have voted for themselves, the Town of Highland Beach will not hold a General Election on March 10, 2026. Candidates will be sworn in to office in March of 2026 during the Town Commission Special Meeting/Swearing In Ceremony.
